


These reports serve as the basis for determining violations and, when applicable, issuing notices and imposing penalties. For FY 2024, a total of 22,483 establishment visits were conducted, along with the inspection of 41,458 fertilizer and pesticide products. As a result, 874 violations were identified. However, all reported violations were addressed or resolved, leading to no penalties being imposed.

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
