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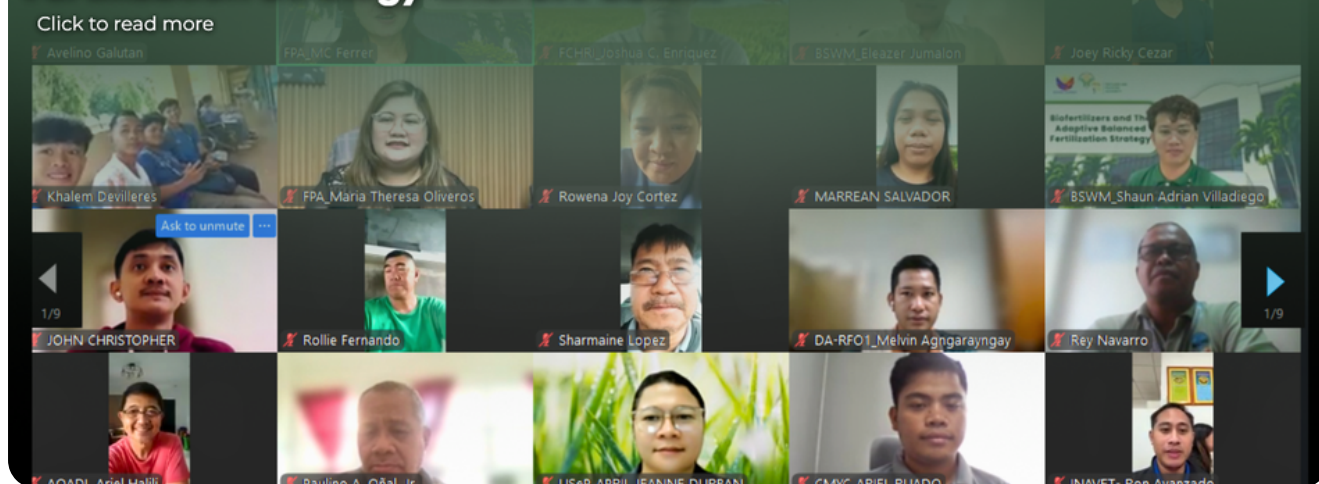

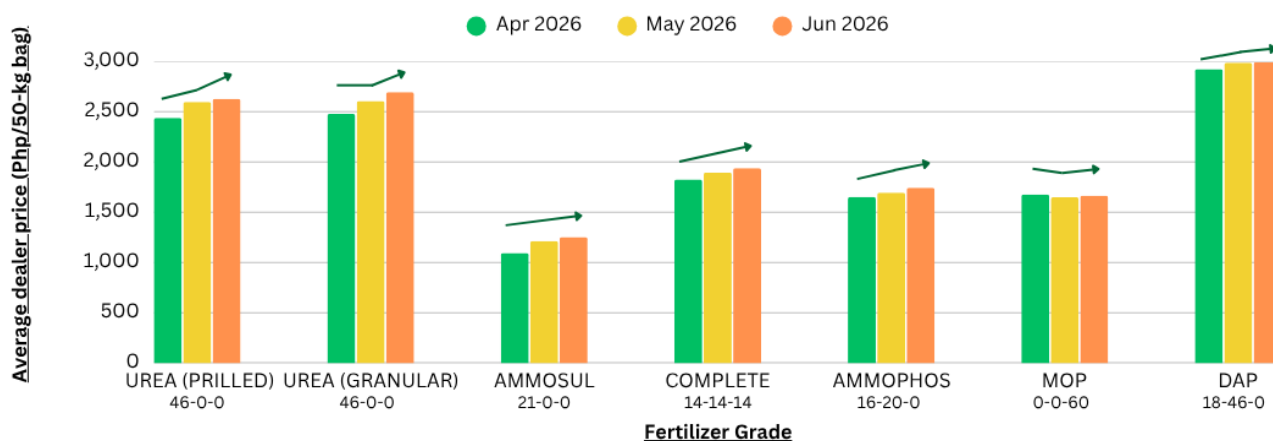

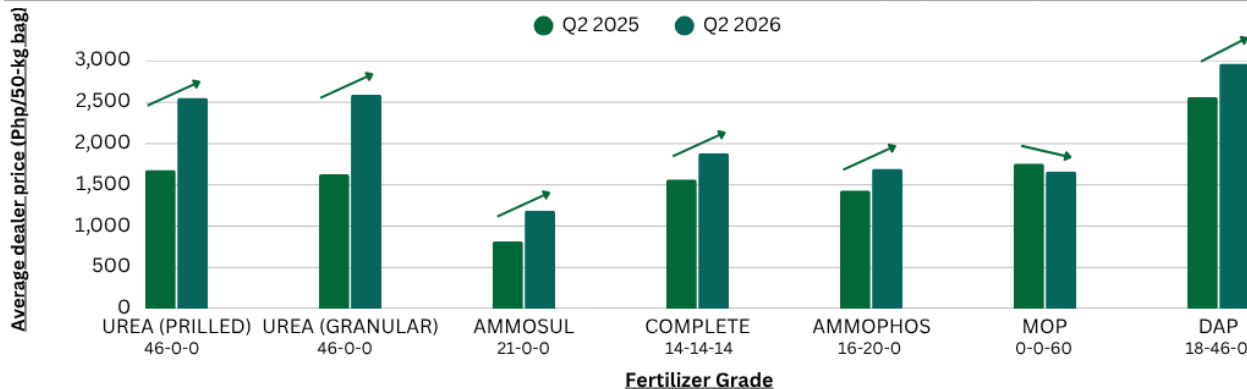

Compared to the **second quarter of 2025**, the average dealer prices of most major fertilizer grades recorded substantial increases during the second quarter of 2026.

Urea (Granular) posted the highest increase at 59%, equivalent to Php 964.53 per 50-kg bag, followed by **Urea (Prilled)** with a 52% increase or Php 871.81 per bag. **Ammosul** recorded a 45.6% increase (Php 372.13), while **Complete fertilizer** increased by 21% (Php 321.39). **Ammophos** and **DAP** also registered price increases of 18% (Php 264.72) and 16% (Php 405.37), respectively. Meanwhile, **Muriate of Potash (MOP)** was the only major fertilizer grade to record a price decline, decreasing by 5% or Php 95.03 per 50-kg bag.
